

Your child has a right to attend kindergarten

1. Why should my child attend kindergarten?

- Kindergarten is a place where children play, make friends and develop social and learning skills.
- Your child will learn Norwegian and become familiar with Norwegian culture.

Attending kindergarten prepares your child for starting school.

2. Is my child safe in kindergarten?

Yes. All children are safe and well cared for by kind and qualified adults.

3. How can I tell if my child is thriving in kindergarten?

You will be in close contact with the staff working in the kindergarten. Together, you will decide what is best for your child.

4. How can I get a place in kindergarten for my child?

- Your child may be entitled to 20 hours of free kindergarten per week.
- If you have a low income, you may be entitled to reduced parents' fees.
